**ORDER ON APPLICATION FOR EXCEPTION
TO SINGLE SALE MORATORIUM**

On February 11th, 2009, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) held a Fact Finding Hearing to consider the application filed by Class A Retailer W & R, Inc., t/a Cairo Liquor Store (Applicant), 1618 17th Street, N.W., for an exception to the statutory single sale moratorium that currently exists in Ward 2.


The official records of the Board reflect that the Applicant has provided the required information, including a letter from Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 2B supporting the Application. The Board considered several factors in reaching its decision. This included the testimony and support of the witnesses, the absence or presence of any primary or secondary tier violations, evidence regarding adverse community impact and other supporting documentation comprising the Board's official file.




