

4. Copies of this Order shall be sent to the Protestant and the Applicant.





## VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT

THIS VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT made this 24 day of October, 2002, by and between COSI, INC. ("Applicant") and ADVISORY NEIGHBORHOOD COMMISSION 2B ("ANC 2B").

## WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Applicant has applied for approval of the reissuance of a Retailer's License Class CR (the "License") issued by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board of the District of Columbia for premises located at 1350 Connecticut Avenue, NW, Washington, D.C. (the "Premises"), Application no. 35112;

WHEREAS, ANC 2B has filed a written objection to the approval of the reissuance of the License pursuant to the provisions of D.C. Code §25-602(a); and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to enter into this Agreement and to request the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to approve of the reissuance of Applicant's License conditioned upon Applicant's compliance with the terms of this written agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals set forth above and the mutual covenants and conditions set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.
2. Applicant shall maintain its outside café seating to the shaded area reflected on Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein, unless otherwise ordered by the Public Space Committee. Applicant shall have employees monitor the outside seating to assure that the boundaries reflected on Exhibit A are maintained. Applicant shall use its best efforts to obtain permission from its Landlord to install a barrier, in accordance with public space regulations, to maintain the boundaries of the outside seating area.
3. Applicant shall provide to ANC 2B the name and contact information for the manager of the Premises, or the District Manager, and shall keep ANC 2B advised of any changes in the names or contact information.
4. ANC 2B hereby withdraws its protest and joins with Applicant in requesting the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to accept this Agreement as a condition of approval to
