Dear Chairwoman Miller and Board Members:

At its regular meeting on April 11, 2012, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above referenced matter. With eight of the nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission protested this application on the basis of peace, order, and quiet and opposes entering into a Voluntary Agreement based on the establishment's history of violations by a vote of (8-0).

At its most recent meeting on June 13, 2012, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") revisited this issue and with seven of the nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of (7-0).

ANC 2B withdraws our protest, on the basis that the establishment has taken concrete steps to address security through a new security plan, and has not had any reported incidents since the implementation of the new security plan.

Commissioner Mike Silverstein did not participate in this matter due to his position on the ABC Board.
