Dear Mr. Alberti:

At its regular meeting on November 9, 2011, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered requests by Crown Liquors. The applicant asked for support for their Class A liquor store license application, and also for a stipulated license. With nine of the nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of 5-0, with 3 abstentions and 1 non-participant:

ANC 2B objects to the stipulated license application by Crown Liquors, 1325 Connecticut Avenue, NW Washington, DC.

We did not take any action on the underlying Class A license application. After we voted to object to the stipulated license, we learned that Class A liquor store applicants might not be eligible for stipulated licenses. We would appreciate clarification on that point from ABRA. Thank you.

Commissioner Mike Silverstein did not participate due to his position on the ABC Board. Phil Carney (phil.carney@dupontcircleanc.net), Mike Feldstein (mike.feldstein@dupontcircleanc.net), and I (will.stephens@dupontcircleanc.net) are the Commission’s representatives in this matter.
