Re: Application by Irish Whiskey for new Class CT license

Dear Mr. Alberti:

At its regular meeting on September 14, 2011, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission (“ANC 2B” or “Commission”) considered the above-referenced matter. Irish Whiskey, located at 1207 19th St NW, submitted an application for new Class CT license. The establishment applied to serve American cuisine with the following criteria: occupancy load 180; sidewalk cafe w/36 seats; hours of operation (interior & sidewalk cafe) Sun-Thu 8am-2am, Fri-Sat 8am-3am; hours of alcohol sales/service/consumption (interior & sidewalk cafe) Sun-Thu 10am-2am, Fri-Sat 8am-3am; entertainment endorsement (DJ) with hours Sun-Thu 6pm-2am, Fri-Sat 6pm-3am. With eight of nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted to protest the application by a vote of (8-0). The Commission’s resolution is as follows:

ANC 2B protests the application on the basis of peace, order, and quiet, subject to the successful negotiation of a Voluntary Agreement or an amendment to the ABC application.
