At its regular meeting on September 7, 2010, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With eight of nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission approved the following motion by a vote of 7-0 (one Commissioner was not participating):

ANC 2B opposes the application by Kabab-Ji Restaurant, 1351 Connecticut Avenue NW, for substantial change to their CR license (ABRA-082446) for entertainment endorsement to include a DJ, music, cover charge, dancing and karaoke on the basis of peace, order, and quiet, pending successful resolution of a Voluntary Agreement.
