Dear Chairman Brodsky:

At its regular meeting on March 9, 2011, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With eight of nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted 7-0 to support the following motion (one Commissioner was not participating):

ANC 2B supports the 14th Street café as requested, but protests the T Street café, on the basis of peace, order, and quiet, subject to negotiations to include the existing signatories of the voluntary agreement.

Commissioner Mike Silverstein did not participate due to his position on the ABC Board.
