At its regular meeting on May 11, 2011, the Dupont Circle Advisory Neighborhood Commission ("ANC 2B" or "Commission") considered the above-referenced matter. With eight of nine Commissioners present, a quorum at a duly-noticed public meeting, the Commission voted 6-0-1 to support the following motion with one Commissioner not participating:

ANC 2B protests the application for this new CR license on the basis of peace, order, and quiet, and adverse effect on parking and vehicular safety, subject to the successful negotiation of a voluntary agreement.
